### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 1 yd home decor fabric, light green
- 15 yds Lion Brand® Chenille Thick & Quick® Yarn, brown
- 1 Fat quarter, yellow
- Sulky® embroidery thread, brown & yellow
- Warm & Natural® cotton batting, 13"x54"
- 2 yds tear-away stabilizer
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies

### DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut two home decor fabric pieces, one batting piece and one tear-away stabilizer piece, each to 13"x52".
2. With tear-away stabilizer under one piece of decorator fabric, zigzag yarn with brown thread to form forsythia branches.
3. Cut 1¼" bias squares out of yellow fat quarter.
4. To make forsythia blossom, pinch center of square, hold in place along branch and triple zigzag with yellow thread over tip. Sew desired number of blossoms on branches.
5. Tear away stabilizer.
6. Finish by sewing fabrics right sides together with batting under embroidered piece, turn, press and sew closed.
