SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Provo Craft® Knifty Knitter™ Round Loom, 9½" diameter
- 2 Skeins Lion Brand® Homespun® yarn
- 14"x6" Neck Roll pillow form
- Crochet hook, size G
- 1 Bolt 5/8" ribbon
- Scissors
- 1 fat quarter of cotton fabric
- Needle and thread
- Flower appliques
- Fabric glue

DIRECTIONS:

1. Using 2 strands of yarn together, follow the basic instructions enclosed in loom package. Leave at least a 6" tail to knot around the end when finished.
2. Knit until pillow cover measures at least 22".
3. Use the crochet hook to remove the knitting from loom following instructions enclosed in package.
4. Cover the pillow form by wrapping fabric around its exterior and sewing the side seam together. Sew a gathering stitch on both ends to bring the fabric close to the pillow form.
5. Insert pillow form into the knitted pillow cover "tube" leaving an even amount of space at each end. Gather the end of knitting on one end, wrap ribbon around it and tie a bow. Repeat on the opposite end.
6. Glue flower appliques in place.

Tip: Hold the loom next to your body when you are slipping the yarn over the top of each knob. It is especially helpful as the knitting gets longer.

Skill Level: No experience needed
