SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Mod Podge® Gloss-Lustre finish
- Solid Tissue Value Assortment
- Scrapbook paper: Mulberry white, vellum
- 1/8" ribbon
- Grocery store freezer paper
- Paintbrush
- Scissors
- Paper punch
- Newspaper
- Optional: Permanent marker

DIRECTIONS:

1. Select colors of tissue paper and cut or tear narrow strips, circles, squares & triangles or random shapes.
2. Paint Mod Podge® on a 12"x15" piece of freezer paper. Place mulberry paper or vellum on top and paint with more Mod Podge®.
3. While still wet, place tissue pieces on wet surface, then paint with Mod Podge® to cover. Allow to dry.
4. Paint several coats of Mod Podge®, allowing it to dry between coats. Turn dry project over and paint Mod Podge® on the reverse side. Allow to dry.
5. Cut project into desired shape and punch hole on top with paper punch.
6. Cut ribbon into 15" lengths. Thread ribbon through the hole and tie in a loop for hanger.

VARIATIONS:

Leaded glass effect: Use permanent marker to draw design on vellum, then color it in with torn pieces of tissue paper.

Textured Effect: Crumple tissue before applying to the surface.

Omit scrapbook paper backing. Apply tissue directly to freezer paper surface. Requires additional coats of Mod Podge® to form a firm background.
