paper collage christmas tree

#### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Aleene's® items:
  - Collage Pauge™ Instant Decoupage™
  - Original Tacky Glue™
- Paper cutter
- Freezer paper
- Christmas print scrapbook papers:
  - 2 red, 2 lime and 2 turquoise
- Snowflake sequins
- Scissors
- Large paintbrush
- Masking tape
- 6" Foam cone
- Wire
- Pencil
- Aluminum foil

#### DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut all paper sheets into equal-sized quarter pieces.
2. Squeeze a puddle of Collage Pauge™ onto a piece of foil. Tape a piece of freezer paper at corners on work surface, shiny side up. Brush papers with Collage Pauge™ and allow to dry overnight.
3. Peel collaged papers from freezer paper. Using paper cutter, cut strips 1" wide.
4. Fold paper strips into loops and glue ends to adhere. Repeat with all strips, leaving one strip unglued for top of tree.
5. Starting at bottom of foam cone, press paper loop in place with looped end towards bottom of tree. Use bits of masking tape to hold loop in place. Repeat all the way around bottom of cone.
6. Alternate paper colors for each layer of tree. Refer to photo for placement. Let dry. Glue remaining strip of paper around top of tree as shown.
7. Squeeze a dot of glue on back of a snowflake sequin. Press in place on a loop. Glue snowflakes randomly all over tree.
8. Draw a freehand star on white paper. Cut out two. Glue back to back between wire. Press wire in top of tree.
