



Knitted Shoulder Blanket

A cool way to keep warm, you'll enjoy making this easy project almost as much as you'll love using it!

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 7 Skeins Sensations™ Angel Hair yarn, Light Green
- Size 17 circular needles
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

DIRECTIONS:

For Front: Make 2

Cast on 36 stitches

Row 1: *K6, P6; rep from * to end.

Row 2-5: Repeat row 1

Row 6: *P6, K6; rep from * to end.

Row 7-10: Repeat row 6

Repeat rows 1-10 until front sections measure 32" long.

Cast off.

For Back:

1. Cast on 96 stitches

2. Repeat front Rows 1-10 until back measures 32" long.

3. Cast off.

4. Stitch fronts to back at shoulder.
