

**Skill level 1
Patch Pillow and Coaster**

Supplies for Pillow:

- ½ yd. Tweed fabric
- ½ yd. Muslin fabric
- 1/3 yd. Organdy fabric
- ¼ yd. Suede cloth
- Assorted beads
- Beading cord
- Scraps of coordinating loosely woven fabric to unravel
- 14" Pillow form
- Tacky glue
- Air erasable marker
- Basic sewing supplies

Supplies for Coaster:

- 3 Tweed fabric squares, 4" x 4"
- 2 Torn strips of organdy, approximately 1½" x 5"
- Inspiration stick pin (found near scrapbooking supplies)
- Beads
- Pearl cotton, size 5
- Basic sewing supplies

Directions:

Directions for Pillow:

1. Cut one 14" x 14" piece of both muslin and tweed fabrics for pillow top. Cut two 14" x 10" pieces of both muslin and tweed fabrics for pillow back flaps.
2. Cut one 14" x 7" piece of suede. Cut one 14" x 11" piece of organdy.
3. With right sides together, sew suede to pillow top 6" from edge, flip open and finger press.
4. Fold organdy in half lengthwise and press. Place organdy on pillow top with raw edges together perpendicular to suede. Open up one layer, sew on fold, and close.
5. Sew muslin flap pieces to matching tweed fabric along one long side. Turn and press with seam enclosed between layers.
6. Layer with pillow top facing up and the two flaps overlapping each other face down. Sew all around, turn, and press.
7. Unravel fabric scraps as desired by pulling out some of the threads in each direction. String beads, and glue in place on pillow top with unraveled fabric scraps.

Directions for Coaster:

1. Fold two tweed squares in half. Fold organdy strip with each half.
2. Place folded squares on top of remaining tweed square with folds facing each other, raw edges aligned with bottom square's raw edges.
3. Sew all around ½" from raw edges.
4. Unravel fabric from raw edges to sewn line.
5. String beads on pearl cotton and sew on coaster as desired.
6. Add beads and stick pin as desired.
