

**Skill level 2
Lime Fleece Shawl**

Supplies:

- Aleene's® Platinum Bond™ Super Fabric Textile Adhesive™
- Fleece, 5/8 yard
- Fringe, 4" x 1¼ yds
- Fancy Fleece™ Ruler from June Tailor®
- Ribbon Coordinating Colors:
- Stripe 1" x 1½yds.
- Solid Color 1/2" x 2-1/2 yds

Tools:

- Rotary Cutter
- Cutting Mat
- Scissors
- Clothespins
- Air erasable marker

Directions:

1. Cut a strip of fleece about 19" wide by width of fabric, using wavy edge of Fancy Fleece Ruler and a rotary cutter. Cut ends straight to create shawl.
2. Using an air erasable marker, draw lines across 3" & 4" from straight edge ends. Between these markings to cut slits perpendicular to the line marking one inch apart for weaving.
3. Weave striped ribbon in and out of slits. Tie knots in ends of ribbon. Apply small dots of glue between ribbon and fleece to hold in place. *NOTE: Because of loft of fleece, constant pressure for a few minutes is needed to ensure glue will attach pieces together.*
4. Apply glue to back of solid color narrow ribbon. Attach on each side of woven area.
5. Fold ends under. Glue down. *NOTE: Use clothespins to hold until dry.*
6. Apply glue to fringe. Attach along straight end of scarf using clothespins to hold in place. Allow all glue to dry before moving.
