# Easter Basket & Eggs

## SUPPLIES:

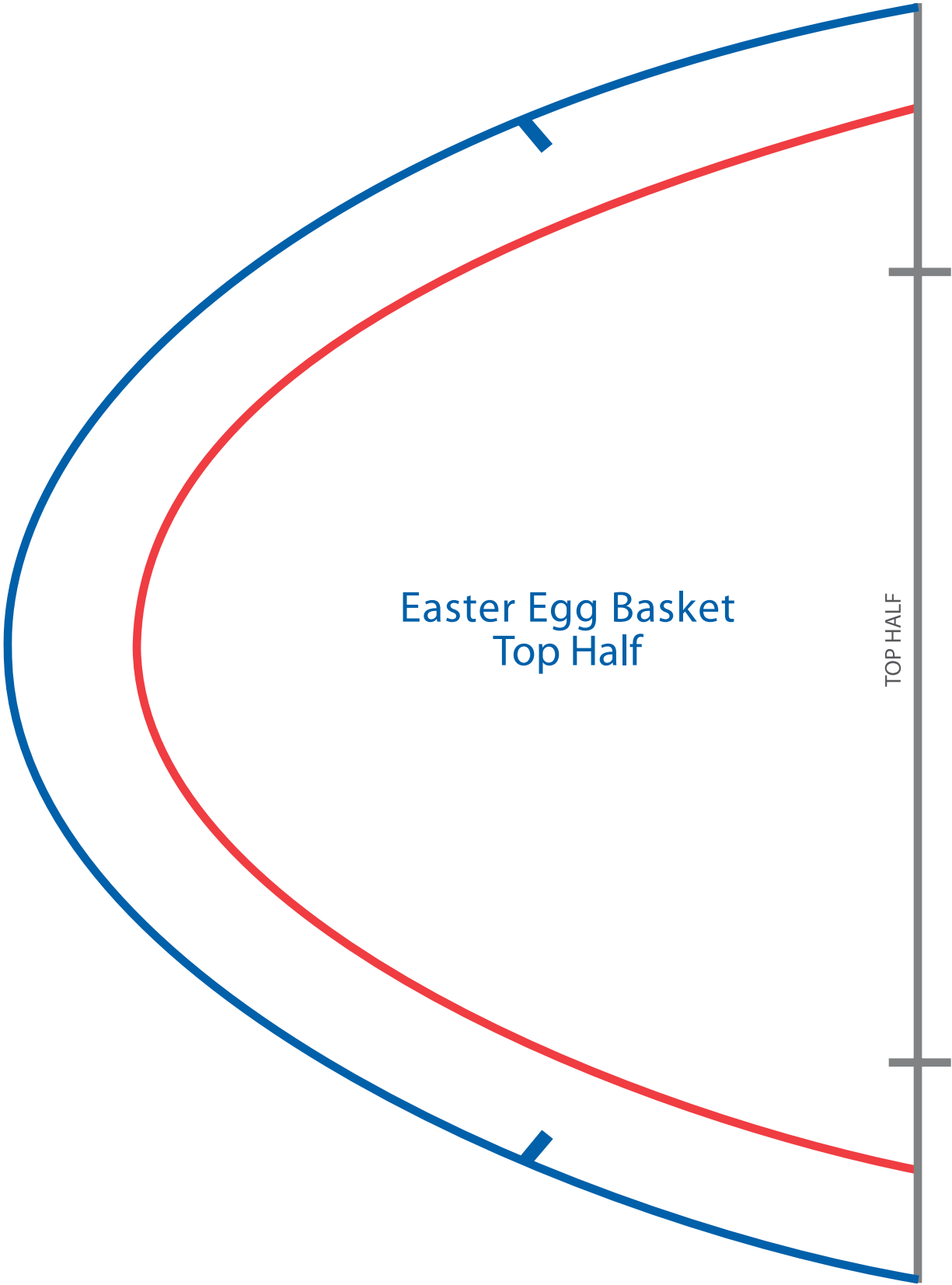
- 1 yd. Winnie the Pooh Easter Fabric
- $\frac{3}{4}$  yd. Quilters Only Waterfall
- $\frac{3}{4}$  yd. Quilters Only Pale Iris
- $\frac{3}{4}$  yd. Quilters Only Pink
- $\frac{1}{4}$  yd. Pellon® stabilizer 50
  
- 1 pkg. Steam-A-Seam® 2 fusible web
- 36" 18-gauge floral wire
- 12 2" Styrofoam® eggs
- Sequin pins or craft glue

## BASKET INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut four 12" X 14" rectangles from Winnie the Pooh fabric, cut two from fusible web (you will need to piece together), and one from stabilizer. Make a sandwich with stabilizer in the center, fabric on the outside and webbing in between. Press, following webbing instructions. **Cut one egg using pattern provided.** (Tape the pieces of the pattern together so you can cut one continuous egg.)
2. Tear several 2" strips from the four fabrics. Start with three strips, staggered in length. Knot ends and braid together. As each strip ends add on another, alternating colors. Continue braiding until you have approximately 4 yds. of braid.
3. Place braid on egg base at edge. Hand-stitch to base. Continue coiling braid around and around egg base until you have four rows. Hand-stitch braid together as you go. Knot end and tuck raw edges under.
4. Make 2 more braids 19" long. Knot each end and insert an 18" piece of wire as you go. Place handles on basket as desired. Slipstitch to sides. Use remaining strip to tie bow on handles.

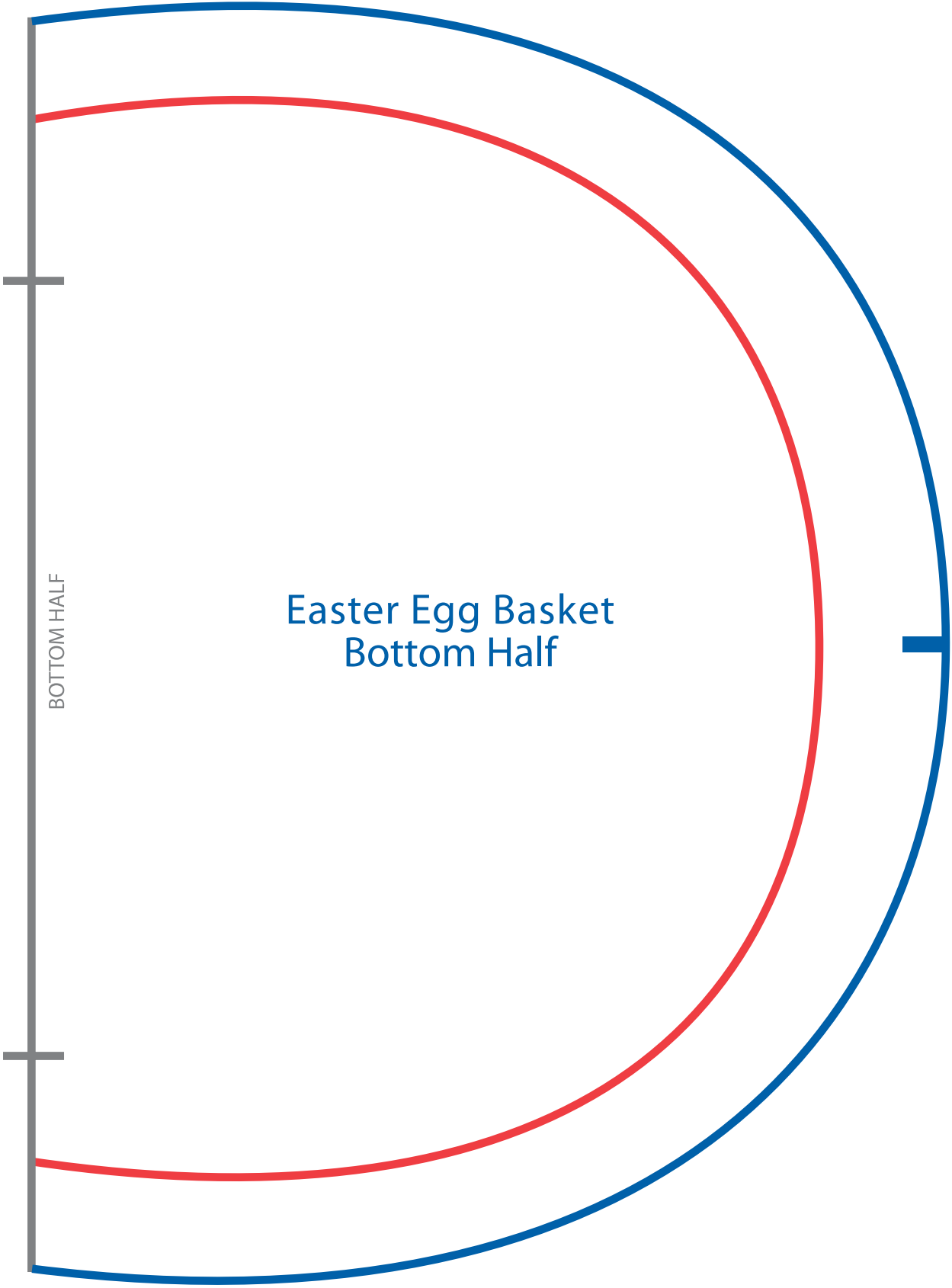
## COVERED EGG INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Tear strips from fabric. Pin or glue on end to Styrofoam® egg. Wrap strips as neatly or as randomly as desired. Pin or glue to secure ends.
2. Cut out characters from Winnie the Pooh fabric. Pin to side of egg. Wrap remainder of egg with fabric strips to frame image.

# Easter Purse

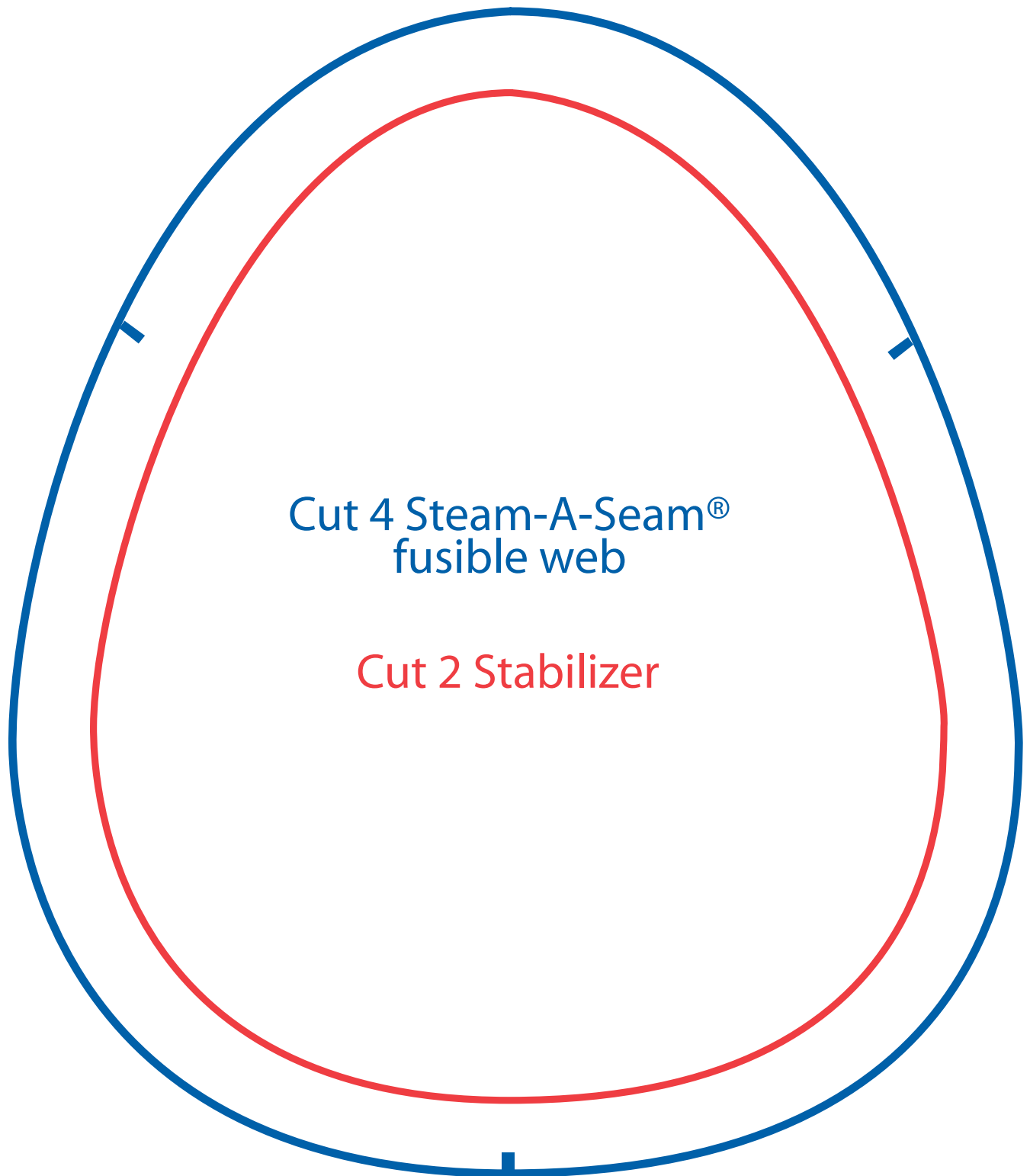
## SUPPLIES:

- ½ yd. Snoopy® Easter Fabric
- ⅛ yd. Quilter's Only Blue Bell
- ⅛ yd. Quilter's Only White
- ¼ yd. Pellon® stabilizer 50
- 1 pkg. Steam-A-Seam® 2 fusible web
- 1 skein size 5 white Pearl Cotton
- 1 pkg. Favorite Findings Easter Day
- 1 pkg. Wrights® Baby Rick Rack

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Using pattern provided, cut 4 eggs from fusible web. Place eggs on **WRONG** side of Snoopy® fabric. Using pinking sheers, cut fabric ½" larger than fusible web.
2. Using pattern provided cut 2 eggs from stabilizer. Fuse together 2 fabric eggs **WRONG** sides together with stabilizer egg sandwiched in between.
3. Transfer marks from egg pattern to fabric eggs. Decorate egg by stitching Rick Rack stripes on a slight curve. Place scraps of fusible web between pieces of printed fabric flowers. Cut out. Pinch flower in center. Stitch to side of purse with an egg button in center. Using Pearl Cotton, sew a running stitch along top edge of each egg, between marks.
4. To make purse strap: Tear a 2½" strip across width of printed white and blue fabrics. Trim all three strips to be equal in length. Lay strips on top of each other. Stitch across 8½" from end. Braid to 8½" from opposite end. Stitch across at 8½" from end. Place both ends together. Stitch through all layers ½" from end.
5. Matching marks on egg to stitching across straps and seam at base of egg, stitch strap to egg ½" from cut edge. Repeat for second side.

## SUPPLIES FOR MOTHER'S APRON:

2¼ yd. Easter Egg Fabric

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut all pieces according to the cutting layout. *See Illustration 1.*
2. With right sides together fold each waist-tie in half lengthwise and stitch one long side and one short side. Leave one short side open for turning. Repeat with the neck straps. Turn and press.
3. Stitch the two waistband pieces right sides together along the top edge. Turn right sides out and press.
4. On the right side of one apron bib piece, place the waistband along the bottom edge keeping raw edges of sides and bottom even. Baste in place.
5. Fold the raw edge of waist-ties in center on either side of apron waistband and baste in place.
6. Measure ½" in on top corners of the bib top. Place the neck-ties at these markings with the raw edges even with the raw edges of the bib top. *See Illustration 2.*
7. With right sides together, stitch the two apron bib pieces together, leaving the bottom edge open. Turn and press. Baste the bottom edge together. *See Illustration 3.*
8. Narrow hem the sides of apron skirt.
9. Hand or machine gather the waist of skirt to fit the bottom of the apron bib.
10. With right sides together, stitch the apron bib to the apron skirt.
11. Fold the ruffle piece in half lengthwise with right sides together. Stitch the two short ends together. Turn and press. Baste the long raw edges together. *See Illustration 4.*



12. Hand- or machine-gather the raw edges of the ruffle to fit the bottom of the apron.
13. Stitch the ruffle to the bottom of the right side of the skirt.
14. Press flat and top-stitch just above the ruffle on the skirt.

### **SUPPLIES FOR CHILD'S APRON:**

$\frac{3}{4}$  yd. Large Bunny Fabric

$\frac{3}{4}$  yd. Small Bunny Fabric

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Cut all pieces according to the cutting layout. *See Illustration 5.*
2. Follow directions 2 through 14 from the Mother's Apron.

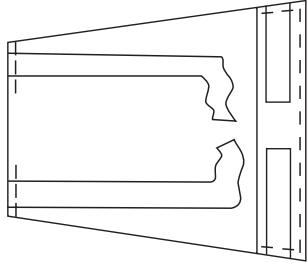

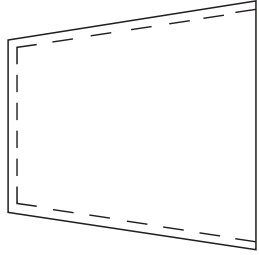
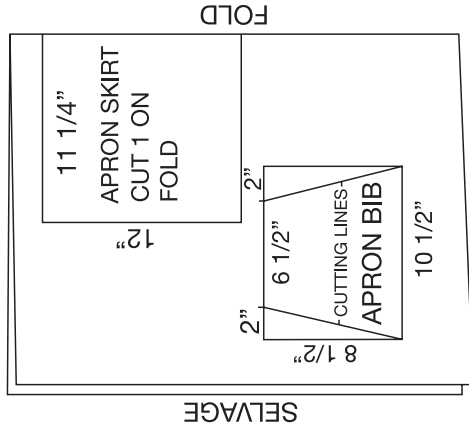

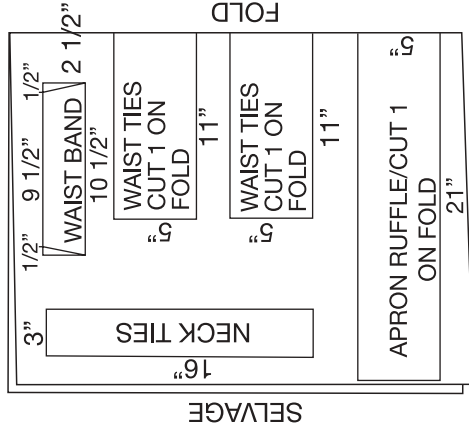
