

## Locker Pockets and Bag Tags

### Supplies for Locker Pockets:

- One 9" x 12" craft foam sheet per pocket
- Ruler
- Decorative-edge craft scissors
- Packing tape
- Aleene's® Foamtastic™ glue
- Small adhesive-backed craft foam shapes, letters and frames
- Strong magnets

### Supplies for Bag Tags:

- Felt squares of assorted coordinating colors
- Self-stick felt shapes: flowers, stars, letters
- Embellishments:
  - Pony beads
  - Fringe trim
  - Perle cotton
  - Buttons
  - Plastic lacing
  - Appliques
  - Ribbon
  - Feathers
- Fabri-Tac® permanent adhesive
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Pinking shears for decorative edges
- Hole punch
- Tapestry needle

### Directions for Locker Pockets:

1. Cut a 9" square from the craft foam, using craft scissors to create a decorative edge.
2. Fold two corners to the center. Fold up the lower corners so the edges overlap the side flaps and will look like an envelope. While pinching the 3 folded flaps together with one hand, secure flaps from the inside of the pocket with packing tape.
3. Glue the overlapped edges together and place a heavy book on top of the envelope to keep flat while drying.
4. Attach decorative foam shapes to front of pocket as desired.
5. Attach magnets to top and bottom of pocket back.

### Directions for Bag Tags:

1. From felt square, cut out shape for inside portion of book bag tag. Suggested shapes include: 3" square; small heart, 2½" x 3½" rectangle; or 3" circle.
2. Using perle cotton, stitch around outside edges of shape with long running stitches. Arrange self-stick felt shapes as desired and adhere to inner portion of felt tag.
3. Cut out another felt shape, slightly larger than inner shape, to frame inner portion. Glue together.
4. If desired, attach pony beads or fringe trim.
5. Punch hole in upper portion of tag. Cut 12" piece of plastic lacing and insert in hole.

**Skill Level: No experience needed.**

**Approximate Crafting Time: Less than an hour drying time.**
