## "Fire & Ice" Glass Ornament



Designed by Connie Glennon-Hall Capture the spark of fire and glint of ice in one ornament. No painting required, just drizzle paints over each other for a special

effect.

## **Supplies:**

- Long glass spiral ornament
- Liquid Rainbow paints:
  - Gold Pearl
  - Orange Lollipop
  - Holiday Red Glitter
  - Fuchsia
  - Crystal Glitter
- Ribbon

## **Tools:**

- Hanger for suspending ornament (i.e., a bent metal coat hanger)
- Acetate sheet
- Toothpick or straight pin

## **Directions:**

Note: The key to making drip ornaments is having all your supplies ready so you can work quickly. If there is a fan in your room, turn it off so paints do not dry too quickly, causing a "paint slide."

- 1. Cover work surface with acetate sheet (to catch paint drips). Suspend ornament from hanger and squeeze on Gold Pearl around the top loop. Immediately add the other colors, allowing them to blend and drip down the spiral.
- 2. Add Crystal Glitter as the final layer.
- 3. As the ornament dries, you may want to gently remove the bottom drip with a toothpick.
- 4. Tie bow with ribbon, affixing it to top of ornament.



**Skill Level:** No experience necessary. **Approximate Crafting Time:** 15 min.
