

Skill level 1
Foam Masks

Supplies:

- 12" x 12" foam sheets:

For bear:

- Green
- Lime green

For monkey:

- Red
- Orange

- Black felt-tip marker
- Yarn

Tools:

- Sharp scissors
- Straightedge ruler
- Foam glue
- 1/8" Hole punch

Directions:

1. Enlarge mask patterns 145% on photocopier; cut out.
2. For bear, use pattern to cut 1 head, 1 nose and 2 inner ears from green foam. Cut 1 muzzle and 2 inner ears from lime green foam. Cut out eyes. Referring to photo for placement, glue inner ears to outer ears and nose to muzzle. Using marker, draw mouth below nose on muzzle. Glue muzzle and ears to head.
3. For monkey, use pattern to cut 1 head and 1 mouth from red foam. Cut 1 muzzle and 2 ears from orange foam. Cut out eyes. Referring to photo for placement, glue mouth to muzzle. Using marker, draw nostrils above mouth on muzzle. Glue muzzle and ears to head. Let glue dry thoroughly.
4. For each mask, cut 2 lengths of yarn for ties. Punch 1 hole on either side of mask. Thread yarn through holes, knotting 1 end to secure.
