couch caddy



SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Wool Felt Fabric:
 - 11 1/2" x 36" piece: Periwinkle
 - 9" x 6" piece: Robin's egg blue
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- Metal- edged ruler
- Pencil
- Embroidery floss
- Embroidery needle

DIRECTIONS:

1. Lay the Periwinkle felt piece on table. Fold end up to create a 8 1/2" pocket. Pin in place.
2. Using a 1/2" seam allowance, sew the pocket sides.
3. Center the Robin's Egg Blue felt on the pocket of the periwinkle felt piece.
4. Using 3 strands of embroidery floss, straight stitch down center of small pocket through both layers of felt. Be careful to stitch only the top layer of the magazine pocket.
5. Continue to stitch the border of the pocket, leaving the top open.
6. Caddy is now complete. Tuck opposite end of caddy between cushion and arm rest of chair to hold in place.
