Guimpe & Passementerie

Guimpe is a narrow flat trim made with a tightly woven tiny cord-like material. This trim is made in such a way that it will turn easily when trimming complex surfaces.

Guimpe can be sewn by hand or machine, as well as glued, to trim pillows, furniture, curtains, lamp shades, apparel and craft items.

Passementerie is an elaborate scroll-like design usually made by knitted metallic or other fibers that can be hand or machine sewn or glued to projects. It is often used as a top trim on special occasion apparel and home decor projects. Passementerie is a great choice to use on holiday pageant garments, ornaments and gifts, as well as Halloween costumes.

Pom-pom Fringe

Pom-pom fringe has evenly spaced pom-pom balls attached to a plain or decorative header in a variety of sizes.

It can be hand or machine sewn or glued, inserted into a seam or onto the surface to allow the header to show. An additional header, flat braid or trim may be added to the pom-pom fringe header for a decorative touch. Pom-pom fringe looks great layered or around the edge of a pillow, table cloth or valance. It is especially fun to add to totes, purses and costumes.




Twist Cord

Twist cord has 2, 3 or 4 plies of different twisted colors or fibers, with or without a lip.

The lip cord can be inserted in between 2 layers of fabric so only the cord is visible and is traditionally used on pillows and slipcovers. Lip cord may be used in the seams of garments as an embellishment. Cords without the lip are used as drawstrings or may be sewn on top of a garment passementerie style, such as for frog closures. Twist cord can be hand or machine sewn or glued onto craft projects, jewelry, home decor projects or apparel like: shoes, belts, totes and purses.


Raschel Lace

Raschel lace has delicate and intricate patterns that are often detailed with scallops and chain stitches. This lace is available with a gathered edging (held by netting or decorative header) or flat with one or two decorative edges.


The gathered lace is great for layering and can be inserted in to a seam by hand or machine. The flat lace can be hand or machine stitched on to garments or home décor projects. Flat lace can be gathered by running a loose running stitch along one side of the lace and pulling the thread gently to achieve the desired gathers.

This beautiful lace is a great way to embellish any project.

Cluny Lace

Cluny lace has a crocheted appearance and is often constructed with a heavier 100% cotton or cotton blend thread. This lace gives a vintage and handmade look and feel.

Cluny can be sewn by hand, machine or glued on craft or sewing projects. It is often used on pillows, towels, photo frames, albums, hats, totes and purses. Simple flowers can be made for pins to embellish projects or use as an accessory. Cluny lace can be inserted into seams, used as an edging on skirts and blouses, made into bows or as an accent on clothing by simply following the natural lines or seams of the garment.

Venice Lace

Venice is a heavily embroidered lace design with no background fabric. Its elegant and rich appearance makes it a perfect choice for a bridal and special occasion embellishment.

Steeped in tradition, Venice can make any project feel special. It can be glued, hand or machine sewn on to clothing as well as craft projects; photo albums, frames, pins and headbands.

Eyelet

Eyelet lace is made by embroidering the edges of the cutwork on fabric. It is available in flat, ruffled or header styles.

Eyelet is hand or machine sewn into or on top of the seams of clothing, curtains, pillows, duvet covers and all crafts. With its light-weight look and feel it is especially fun to apply to summer apparel. For an added embellishment, eyelet lace can be layered or ribbon can be woven through the openings. Eyelet can also be glued onto many craft projects.
